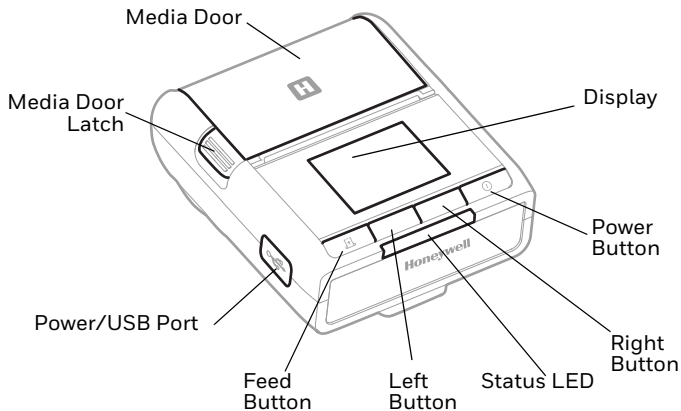

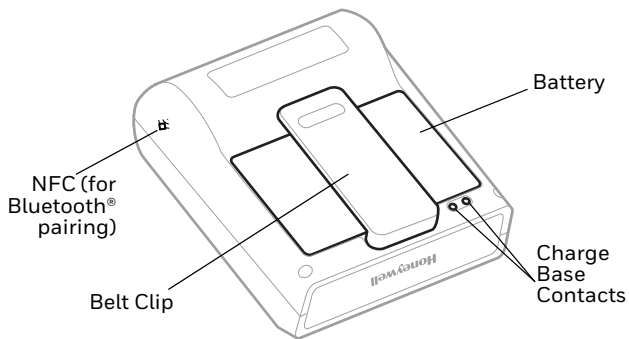
Make sure your shipping box contains the following:

Do not remove battery while printer is being charged.

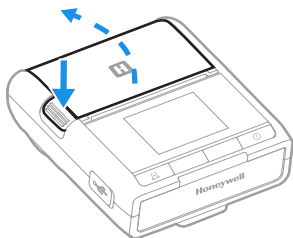
Hot Swap

You can replace the battery on demand provided the following condition is met:

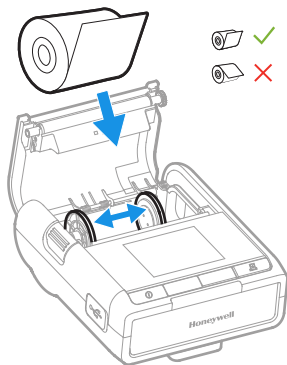
- Printer is not being charged.

Buttons

Button	Action	Result
(any)	Short press (when printer is in Sleep mode)	Wake printer and activate display.

 Power	Press (when printer is off)	Turn printer on.
	Long press (when printer is on)	Turn printer off.
	Short press (when display is active)	Result is determined by the icon on the user display (refer to the Display Icons table).
 Feed	Press (when display is idle)	Feed label or paper length.
	Press (when display is active)	Result is determined by the icon on the user display (refer to the Display Icons table).
Left	Press (when display is active)	Open the main menu, or move between menu options and settings.
Right	Press (when display is active)	Move between menu options and settings.

Menu Options	Press to:
 Print Settings	View or change printer settings, such as paper width, darkness, media type, print speed and command set.
 Device Config	Set sleep mode, password, and other settings as well as restore factory defaults.
 Bluetooth	View Bluetooth information.
 WiFi	View Wi-Fi connection information.
 About	View the printer's serial number, firmware version, print mileage, and battery voltage.
 Self Test Page	Print a self-test page.

Status Indicator

State	Description
Red (when display is idle)	Printer is in Sleep mode.
Red (when display is active)	Alert (for example: media door is open, media is out, the battery is low, or an error has occurred.)

Audible Indicator

Beeps	Description
2 short beeps	Event notification (for example: printer has been turned on, battery charge is complete, firmware update is complete, media door is open, media is out, battery is low, or an error has occurred.)
